DIED IN DISCHARGE OF DUTY.

Double Pneumonia Killed Long Island City Ambulance Driver.

John Wallace, 27 years old, employed for several years as night driver of the ambulance attached to St. John's Hospital, died Wednesday night in that institution of pneumonia. Wallace answered an early morning call Sunday, and on his return to the hospital collapsed and the physicians said he was suffering from double pneumonia. He was put to bed and received every attention, but grew worse gradually until his death.
