

Military Funeral For Peter J. Kelly

The funeral of Peter J. Kelly, 29, an ambulance driver for the Methodist Hospital, and a World War II Navy veteran, will be held Monday from his home, 1663 8th Ave. A solemn requiem mass will be offered at 9.30 a.m. in Holy Name R. C. Church, Prospect Park West and Prospect Ave. Burial, with military honors, will be in Long Island National Cemetery, Pinelawn.

Mr. Kelly died Wednesday in the Methodist Hospital, where he was operated on last Friday after suffering a cerebral hemorrhage. He was stricken while driving the ambulance. The interne noting that the driver was in distress, took the wheel and brought the ambulance to a halt. Soon after Mr. Kelly collapsed and never regained consciousness.

Mr. Kelly was a son of Thomas and Catherine Kelly and attended Holy Name Parochial School. During the war he was stationed at a naval base in Newfoundland. He was a member of the McFadden Brothers Post, American Legion.

Besides his parents, he is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Mae McCarthy and Mrs. Catherine Valente.
