

Rites for Hannah Callahan, Slain Ambulance Attendant

A delegation from the Department of Hospitals and Kings County Hospital, including First Deputy Commissioner Maurice H. Matzkin, formed a guard of honor today at the funeral of Hannah Callahan, 50, of 206 Sumpter Ave.

Miss Callahan, an ambulance attendant, was shot to death last Friday by a man she was escorting to a Kings County Hospital ambulance. She was buried in Calvary Cemetery

after a mass had been offered for her in Our Lady of Lourdes R. C. Church, Broadway and Aberdeen St.

Slain with Miss Callahan by Edward Rahner, 38, of 509 Woodward Ave., was Patrolman Joseph Norden of the Ridgewood Precinct.

Miss Callahan was killed instantly by a bullet after Rahner wrested a revolver from a policeman on the scene. She is survived by a sister, Margaret.
